

BYLAW NO. 2/2002

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING
THE PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.


The Council of the Summer Resort Village of Wakaw Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

The Summer Resort Village of Wakaw Lake is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as EXHIBIT 'A', with the Rural Municipality of Hoodoo No. 401 for the purpose of receiving fire protection services.

The Mayor and Administrator of the Summer Resort Village of Wakaw Lake are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached Agreement identified as EXHIBIT 'A'.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this 7th day of December, 2009 A.D.

BETWEEN:

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HOODOO NO. 401
hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality"

AND THE RESORT VILLAGE OF WAKAW LAKE
hereinafter referred to as the "Resort Village".

THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. The R.M. of Hoodoo is party to an agreement with the Town of Wakaw and the Town of Cudworth which provides the authority for the R.M. of Hoodoo to enter into an agreement with the Resort Village Park on behalf of the Hoodoo-Wakaw and Hoodoo-Cudworth Fire Departments for the purpose of providing fire protection and fire prevention.
2. The Parties hereto agree to provide fire protection services to all residents and property in the Resort Village.
3. The Parties hereto agree that it shall be the responsibility of the Town of Wakaw or Cudworth fire chief to dispatch the necessary equipment when needed. The fire chief shall also be responsible to determine the priority of service in the case of simultaneous fires having regard for human protection first and property protection last.
4. All costs and responsibilities relating to the operation of the fire departments belong solely to the respective fire departments.
5. The Parties hereto agree that there shall be an annual charge of \$36.30 per annual leased site, cottages and buildings to the R.M. of Hoodoo. The Resort Village shall be responsible to notify the Municipality of the number of annual leased sites, cottages and buildings.
6. The Parties hereto agree the R.M. of Hoodoo may charge the Resort Village for fire protection at the rate as per Appendix "A". Appendix "A" subject to change by mutual agreement. The collection of that charge shall be the responsibility of the Resort Village and shall be paid to the R. M. of Hoodoo within sixty days of billing date.
7. This Agreement shall be in place from the date of signing to December 31, 2012. The Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving 60 days notice in writing to the other party.
