

Sandy Point Parking Bylaw

RESORT VILLAGE OF WAKAW LAKE

BYLAW NO 03/13

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A SPACE DESIGNATED FOR PEOPLE WITH NO ON-SITE PARKING SPACE.

The Council of the Resort Village of Wakaw Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw will be known as the Sandy Point Parking Bylaw.
2. For the purpose of this bylaw the word:
 - a) Permit means a parking permit issued by the Resort Village of Wakaw Lake Council to the owners of sites Lot 9 Block 13, Lot 1 Block 14, Lot 2 Block 14, and Lot 3 Block 14;
 - b) Vehicle means a personal use vehicle, or a motor vehicle as ascribed to by *The Traffic Safety Act*;
 - c) Council means the Council of the Resort Village of Wakaw Lake; and
 - d) Municipality means the Resort Village of Wakaw Lake
3. No person shall stop or park a motor vehicle in a designated parking space for people as indicated above
 - a) without an authorized permit suspended from the rearview mirror and visible through the front windshield of the vehicle. OR
 - b) have the authorized vehicle license plates registered at the village office for verification.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 3 will have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense.
