As per the Government of Saskatchewan's *Building Code Regulations* every residential building is required to have smoke and carbon monoxide alarms installed by **July 1, 2022.**

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT/ NUISANCE ABATEMENT

There are increasing numbers in rodents and small animals such as racoons, skunks, foxes, and bobcats in the resort. Bylaw enforcement will focus on dilapidated buildings and other nuisances this summer. As per Bylaw 11 – 2010, if you have old sheds, outhouses, and other buildings that could harbour these animals, you will be asked to remove them this year.

BASIC RESTRICTIONS

FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM MATERIALS

- **Household waste only** - No waste marked or sold as commercial, industrial, or agricultural
 - **Original containers only** - No repackaged waste
 - **Original labels only** - Original container must have the original label
 - **Sealed containers only** - Must be leak-proof, generally the original cap must be attached
- **For pesticide container** - must show the Pest Control Product number and the word "Domestic". Note that many common household "pesticides" such as **Roundup, Killex and others DO NOT have a toxic symbol, and are NOT accepted**
- **PAINT IN ANY CONTAINER IS NOT ACCEPTED** - Leftover paint and empty paint cans are **accepted without charge at all SARCAN recycling depots**. A complete list of items accepted under the Saskatchewan Paint Recycling Program can be found on SARCAN's website.

VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTING INSURANCE

It is recommended that each resident carries a least **\$25,000** in coverage for fire-fighting costs. Regular fire insurance does not cover the cost of the fire department invoice. Contact your provider for further information.

WHEN ARE PERMITS REQUIRED?

The Resort Village of Wakaw Lake requires development permits for all projects to ensure that the development standards in *The Zoning Bylaw* are followed. This includes grading, adding gravel, paving, and any alteration to natural drainage. Development permits are also required for sheds to ensure proper setbacks are followed. There is no cost for a development permit.

Development permits are also required for all shoreline development.

Building Permits are required for new builds, sheds over 100 sq ft, decks, gazebos, garages, modular or mobile homes, RTMs, additions, basement developments, and renovations that enlarge the building envelope, add windows or doors, and new exterior and interior wall locations. There is a \$50 fee for the building permit application and additional fees set out by the building inspector for plan reviews, inspections, etc.

Building and developing without proper permits is illegal and can be costly. If development standards are not followed, you will be asked to comply with the Zoning Bylaw. If you are unsure if you require a permit, please call the office.
