Snowmobile Safety and New Bylaw

Please be advised that there is a new Bylaw for ATV's & Snowmobile's; Bylaw 5-2025 will be uploaded to our website mid-December, and will contain important information regarding their operation within the Resort Village. Please keep an eye out for continuous Bylaw updates as we review our current register. Some safety tips: a) wear a proper fitting helmet, b) use due care and attention when operating, c) inform someone of your plans, d) be cautious on ice and e) ensure your snowmobile is properly registered and insured.

Outstanding Taxes & Trailer Fees - Final Reminder

Please be advised that taxes and trailer fees are due by December 31st of each year. If you have outstanding taxes and/or fees as described above, you would have received a reminder notice in the mail this past month. If taxes remain unpaid after December 31st, your taxes will be in the arrears and a 10% interest fee will be added immediately on January 1st.



Bylaw Enforcement

Council has appointed CAO, Danielle Vandale, as the new Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Resort Village of Wakaw Lake. You may see her around as she performs weekly inspections. Council has authorized her to perform the following tasks: issue Orders to Remedy when contraventions occur, monitor development permits, building permits, and orders to remedy, monitor boat launch and beach area, issue violation notices when required, ensure that applicable legislation is followed, and report to Council on a monthly basis. If you see her out and about, please feel free to introduce yourself or give her a friendly wave as she becomes familiar with our small resort village.



Winter Road Conditions

Although we do our best with the roads in the winter, there may be times that conditions will be challenging and will require making alternate arrangements. The speed limit within the village is 30 km/h; please be cognizant of road conditions and slow down, especially when there are more people around during the holiday season.
