### **Business Licensing**



Please be advised that annual Business License Renewal invoices have been sent out to the active businesses on file. If you are a new business in the resort village, or are no longer a business in the resort village, please contact the office to update your file. Business License application forms are required for new businesses, and renewal forms for existing businesses. The annual licensing fee is \$100.00.

### **Bylaw 11-2010 Nuisance Abatement Bylaw**

We would like to remind residents of the above noted bylaw, as it pertains to property in the village. Please review the bylaw and take note of the sections regarding dilapidated buildings, unoccupied buildings, overgrown grass and weeds, untidy and unsightly property, junked vehicles, open excavations, maintenance of yards and outdoor storage of materials. As mentioned in the previous newsletter, we will be monitoring properties for contravention of this bylaw as a priority for this year, as we want all residents and visitors alike to enjoy a safe and sightly environment. This bylaw is available on our website or in the office.

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## **Burnt out streetlight??**

Is there a burnt out streetlight in your area? This is a reminder to please report any streetlight issues to SaskPower. Simply log on to the SaskPower website, click on Report Streetlight Troubles > Report Streetlight Outages > Enter postal code S0K4P0 > once loaded, click on the streetlight on the village map. This information goes directly to SaskPower and ensures it is being looked after in a timely manner.



## **Looking ahead**

As we look ahead and into the future, Council will be diligently working on creating a Strategic Plan for the resort village. To support our strategic initiatives, our CAO will be busy creating a multi-year budget, as well as applying for grants to benefit our community. Future plans include but are not limited to:



- Acquisition of a heavy-duty utility vehicle
- Public Access improvements / projects
- General improvements: clearing trees and stumps, installation of new playground equipment, new portable washroom
- Humane beaver control efforts such as the purchase of a pond leveller (beaver deceiver)
- Kids summer days and events
