Saskatchewan Lake Stewardship Summit 2026

Council member Lorne Thomson attended the Saskatchewan Lake Stewardship Summit on February 11th, 2026 in Saskatoon. Some items that may be of interest to residents are as follows:

-Their research has revealed that Wake Boats should only operate in water that is at least 20 feet or 5 meters deep, and at least 500 feet from any shoreline. If you are interested in further

information, Google search University of Minnesota and Wisconsin Wake Boat Studies.

- Invasive species monitoring is an ongoing issue and they would like to remind those with watercraft of any kind (even a kayak, paddleboard) must be inspected and border entry check points and spot checks at resorts. Be sure to comply with these check points as it could result in a monetary fine.

- There is a Feral Wild Boar Control Program for reporting wild pigs in your area; website is www.squealonthepigs.com, and last year alone they paid out \$14,000 in damages. If you have an issue with wild boar/pigs on your land, please look into the information on this website. Alternatively, you can contact the SK Ministry of Agriculture via text at 1-833-PIG-SPOT to report wild boar sightings, tracks, scat and rooting.
